



### SIXTH FORM AS/A2 / BTEC/ Vocational COURSES:

To secure a place on an A level programme, you will need to have achieved grade C or above in at least **six** subjects at GCSE **including English Language and Maths**. To be able to take some A level courses, you may need to have achieved an A or a B in particular subjects. For non-A level subjects at Level 3, for students to secure a place in the Sixth Form for study, you will need to have achieved **grade C in English Language and Maths**. For the study of Beauty at Level 3, students are expected to be working towards achieving English Language and Maths GCSE. Please look carefully at the subject requirements on the College website. For Level 2 courses, entry grades will be discussed at interview.
