Why study BTEC Level 3 Diploma in Business?

This is an applied and practical course which provides the essential skills and knowledge for those entering a range of occupations in the business world. The course has been developed with employment in mind to:

- provide students the opportunity to enter employment in the business world;
- provide students with the opportunity to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal skills and attributes essential for successful performance in working life.

This course is equivalent to two GCEs (A-Levels) at grades A* to C.

Course details

All students must complete four mandatory units:

- The Business Environment
- Business Recourses
- Introduction to Marketing
- Business Communication

And eight optional units that can consist of:

- Accounting
- Marketing
- Human Recourses
- Management
- Law
- Administration
- Retail
- General Business
- Logistics

How is the course taught and assessed?

There are no external examinations and all your work is assessed by your teacher.

Learning is through the consideration and investigation of real business situations and problems and the search for solutions. Students are encouraged to read news articles and watch business programmes. They will have the opportunity to visit businesses and hear business speakers.

Entry requirements

Students will have achieved 6 GCSEs at grade C or above including English Language and Mathematics. It is not a requirement to have taken GCSE Business Studies.

What are the progression routes with this qualification?

Students are learn a considerable amount about business situations and problems and the search for solutions which can be applied in further studies, entrepreneurial opportunities and/or business apprenticeship.

What extra work can I do?

Students will need to read around the subject and keep up to date with current affairs. It is helpful for student to pursue a work study in a business setting.
