Whole-College Sponsored Walk 8 July

On Monday 8 July, as part of activities week, we are asking all students and staff to participate in a sponsored walk for charity in the local area around Midhurst. The charity we are supporting for our sponsored walk this year is Sussex Snowdrop Trust who support children and families by providing nursing care at home for children with life threatening or terminal illnesses.

The route for the sponsored walk will take us into the South Downs and is a planned route by the National Trust known as the Midhurst Rother Walk, it will be approximately 10 miles long. Students will need a packed lunch on the day, along with water. All staff and students will be eating lunch together. This is a fantastic community event for our students and staff to be involved with, we hope to raise a considerable sum for this charity. Students not meeting the criteria will be expected to wear an item from our loan stock or will be sent home to change.
