Safe Drive Stay Alive

On Wednesday 6 December, Year 12 will be watching the Safe Drive Stay Alive presentation.

Safe Drive Stay Alive is created by West Sussex County Council, Sussex Police and West Sussex Fire and Rescue. It is an innovative education project, exploring the circumstances and consequences of a road traffic collision. Aimed at 16 to 18 year olds in West Sussex, a film of a crash in the local area has been specially prepared, with roads and hospitals familiar to local students. As the drama unfolds and the emergency services arrive on the scene, the faces on film pause and speak to the viewers about their experiences, the reactions of the driver and passengers, the medical implications and how seeing such trauma affects them personally.

We will be with the students during the presentation and are available to support if necessary as we experience this emotional story. Previous students have commented on how powerful and useful the film is, making many think about the importance of road safety and being a safe driver.
