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Attendance

This year we continue to focus on all students achieving 96% attendance. When a student's attendance is below 95% it is a cause for concern. Low attendance results in less time in the classroom and can severely impact on outcomes; for your child to have the best chance and good GCSE grades and future study pathways, please ensure they attend school every day.



Ensuring attendance at school is a parent/carer's legal obligation and we are keen to support parents with this, not least because of the huge amount of national data that proves the correlation between good attendance and academic progress.
