Dear Parent/Carer

**RE: Equipment required for lessons**

Following the February half-term, as a year group team, we will be more effectively supporting our students to attend every lesson with the right equipment.

We wish to support our students to develop the independence and organisational skills needed for life in the wider world. We expect students to attend school with all the required equipment for learning so that they are not reliant on borrowing equipment throughout the school day. Every second counts in our classrooms and we want to ensure that students borrowing/requiring equipment is not a distraction from teaching time.

Your child's tutors will check students' equipment each morning and monitor those who do not have the required equipment.

As a school we are happy to support students with a pencil case starter kit. The pencil case will contain the items listed below as 'essential' equipment. Though the pencil case will not contain a scientific calculator, this is also a part of essential school equipment. To request a starter pencil case please ask your child to speak to their tutor or myself.

Students can purchase school equipment, including Scientific calculators, before school, break, and lunchtime from Student Reception and the school shop on Arbor.

Below is a list of 'essential' and 'desirable' equipment with which students should attend school each day. The impetus is on students to monitor their equipment and source replacements if required. As parents/carers, your support in monitoring your child's equipment for learning regularly as the school year progresses is very much appreciated.


