Y12 Internal Exams

As we near the end of Year 12, it is important for us to assess the progress that your son/daughter has made. To this end, we will be running a series of internal exams in each subject starting on **Tuesday 23 April 2019**.

The exams will assess the content that has been covered in class through the first two terms and as such, we are expecting students to achieve a minimum achievement of 40% in the papers (roughly an A-level pass grade). Where students achieve below 40% they will be expected to retake the paper later in the term. On retaking the paper, if a student fails to achieve the 40% benchmark we will arrange a meeting with the student and subject teacher to discuss the reasons why and devise a plan of action.

The exam timetables will be issued shortly and it goes without saying that Year 12 students should be very well accustomed to the standards expected of them. I would like to highlight that for the morning sessions, students should be ready to enter the exam room at 8:30am – where transport is likely to result in a delay it is important the College reception is phoned so we can arrange for a later entry to the exam room.
