## Breakfast club

As we enter the last phase of the academic year, I wanted to take the opportunity to thank you for your continued support for your own children and support towards all members of the MRC community. It is wonderful to see students continuing to work hard in lessons and flourish personally.

As part of our commitment to improving the provision for all students here at Midhurst Rother College, I am delighted to inform you that we will be trialling a breakfast club before the end of term, with the hope to fully introduce this as a permanent feature in September 2022.

Breakfast clubs can play a significant role in supporting children and families as it provides easy and regular access to food and allows for social interaction to take place, bringing people together on a daily basis. All members of the MRC community are welcome to attend breakfast club.

For 60p, students will receive a slice of toast, a bowl of cereal and a drink of fruit juice / water. If a student does not wish to have a bowl of cereal, they will be offered two slices of toast instead. For those students who are in receipt of free school meals, this service will be free. Staff will also join students for breakfast, paying a slightly higher tariff.

In addition to the actual breakfast, we will also run fun activities starting with bingo where community members can try to win a free breakfast for the next day. There is no obligation for students to take part in this activity if they do not wish to; sitting, eating breakfast and socialising with friends is also perfectly acceptable.

The Breakfast club will begin on **Monday 11 July** and run until the end of term. Daily service will begin at 7.50am and close at 8.15am. This allows an opportunity for the vast majority of students to access this provision, including those who arrive to College on designated transport. It also allows a further 10 minutes for students to eat their breakfast before they move off to tutor time (or Period 1 on a Friday).

We are excited by this new provision and hope that it will help continue to bring people together and help combat the rise in cost of living.
