Tate Modern Gallery with Expressionist Exhibition

The ADT department is delighted to offer Year 10 and 12 students the opportunity to visit the Tate Modern Gallery in London. This is to view the permanent art collection and visit the exhibition EXPRESSIONISTS- KANDINSKY, MÜNTER AND THE BLUE RIDER. This is a fantastic opportunity to view first hand a wide range of Art and Artisitic techniques. It will also inform students about different Artists and Art Movements, which will help support the coursework being made by students in their Art lessons and inspire the work they create for their personal project.

This trip will take place on Thursday 23 May 2024. Our group will leave Midhurst Rother College at 8am and travel by coach to London returning at 5pm. As our departure and return times are outside school hours, arrival and onward journeys will need to be arranged.

Students are welcome to wear their own clothes however we ask that they be suitable for the occasion including shoes as there will be walking involved. They will also need to bring a small sketchbook and equipment.
