Year 10 - Assessment Window 2

I hope this letter finds you well and you enjoyed the holiday season. You will be aware that we have now moved to a new assessment framework at Midhurst Rother College. This new system means that students will now receive a GCSE style grade for each assessment they sit. In Year 10 there are 3 formal assessment windows: November, January, and June. The maximum grade a student can get in Year 10 is a 7+.

This letter is to inform you that your child will be sitting formal assessments in all subjects. These will be classroom based but will alone form the basis of their second tracking point:

Year 10 Assessment window 2: wb. 16 January until 27 January

Within this window, Year 10 also have formal United Learning Assessments that will take place in the theatre for English, Maths and Science.

Teachers will be working with students to prepare them for these assessments, along with setting relevant revision materials for homework.

Please do speak to your child about the importance of preparing fully for assessments, as it helps us as a College and you to support them in their education.
