Dear Parents / Carers

Our uniform continues to play a valuable role in contributing to the ethos and tone of the College. The way in which students wear our uniform is excellent, and enables them to be part of our community. The high standards in which your child is dressed for College and how they present themselves in their uniform is representative of this and overall, the majority of our students wear the uniform with pride. Wearing the correct uniform correctly is important to us; we will strive to ensure that students represent us in our uniform to the highest standard all the time.

I thank you for your ongoing support in this area and as we make our way toward half term I would like to draw your attention to two key areas as a reminder about our uniform policy:

**Jumpers/coats** – whilst journeys to school may be colder during the winter months, we do not expect to see a range of jumper styles and colours being used as part of students' uniforms. Hoodies are not acceptable in College. Students who wish to wear a jumper with their uniform should wear a black v-neck 100% cotton plain jumper. These are in stock and available from our suppliers, Stevensons, either online or in the Guildford store.

**Piercings** – we accept one piercing; a plain gold or silver stud, worn in the lobe of each ear, no stones or hoops/dangly earrings. No other piercings or retainers on the ear or face are permitted. Students will not be permitted to attend College with a retainer or a plaster over any unhealed piercing. Claiming that any piercing has not healed is not regarded as an acceptable excuse for wearing jewellery.

In the event that these, or any of our uniform standards are not met, parents will be notified and expected to correct it. Students will not be in circulation around our College environment if they are not dressed in accordance with our clear expectations. Our full policy is available on our website.

Our uniform policy has not changed recently, and our expectations remain clear. Thank you for your support in this matter.
