Parents' guide for homework platforms, usernames, passwords and subject deadlines

This document should be used as a guide for families and students when creating bespoke homework schedules. By logging onto Arbor, families and students will be able to create the most effective homework schedule that is personally tailored to individual need.

Aspects to consider:

- On average, students should spend 1 hour per day on homework. This will increase as students' progress through the College into Key Stage 5.
- Deadlines are normally set for a minimum of 4 College days following specific lessons.
- Some subjects are set twice within the same week (sometimes one day apart) due to when a class/lesson falls.

Electronic platforms:

All homework is set on Arbor. Arbor is the student's homework dashboard covering all subjects so they can see what is to be actioned, by what date and to mark as submitted once the work has been completed on the other platforms. By submitting as completed on Arbor, this does not necessarily mean that the homework has been completed as it has been tracked on other platforms (Sparx for example), but it is a tick box for the student to track their homework. There are also other electronic platforms which are used by different subject areas. Some require Microsoft logins, which consist of the student's College email and College password, whereas others utilise a mixture of college set passwords, and the student's own choice of password. Please see below for more details.
