I would like to thank all students for their excellent behaviour and the respect they showed during last week's Remembrance assembly. It is at times like these when we see the very best in your children and they deserve huge credit for their behaviour and conduct.

I am grateful to the parents who joined me for the parents' forum meeting this week. This is a meeting where the agenda is directed by the parents and is intended as a way for parents / carers to give feedback to the school. The areas that were raised this week included:

The day started with simple techniques of pining and cutting out, threading a needle, basic hand sewing stitches and introduction to using a sewing machine. Students then went on to use these skills as they used contrasting fabrics for design impact using their artistic eyes and attention to detail, along with a lot of creative imagination to make a unique festive item.

Tickets are available on the door and refreshments will be available. The evening is looking to be a spectacular showcase of our music, drama and dance students, we hope to see lots of you there!



#### **Assessments**

#### Year 8, 9 and 10

Assessments have all now been completed, apart from a handful of 'mop-up' sessions. Well done to all the year groups for their hard work and focus during these assessments. Teacher will now be marking those assessments and providing feedback in forthcoming lessons shortly. Tracking point reports for Year 9 and 10 are due next week, with Year 8 due in the first week of December.

#### Year 7

Year 7 have their first round of assessments in subjects where they did not have a 'baseline assessment' next week. These assessments are intended to help teaching staff get a feel for how students are settling into their learning here at MRC. They are very much 'low stakes' assessments; we will use them to identify any students who might benefit from some additional support in-class (or, exceptionally, outside the usual curriculum) and to celebrate those who have made an exception start to their time here, in terms of both their academic attainment and their effort in the classroom. We will share the outcome of these assessments in a tracking point report in the first week of December.

Please be aware that, on return in January, Year 7 will sit their 'Mid-Year' exams in classroom-based assessments. We will share more information regarding those before the Christmas Holidays.




