Teaching Values

Our values of *respect, happiness and achievement* were chosen by our students and they form the core principles upon which our decisions are made. In every assembly we talk about, and remind students to, 'be kind' and that this is what it means to be a member of our school community, both in and out of College. We deliver our values each week by using different curriculum vehicles, whilst also promoting Fundamental British Values that are inherent in our society. Our values are best showcased through:

- 1. **Tutor time** every week there is a theme linked to our values, which is explored through our local context, world events or linked to protected characteristics and awareness.
- 2. Assemblies key messages are promoted through whole College, year group and House assemblies.
- 3. **PSHE** lessons a wide range of subjects make up the curriculum from personal finance, mental and physical health to sex and relationships education.
- 4. **Charity work** giving back to others is a key part of College life. Students are taught how and why charity work can benefit others, the impact that they can have, and what part they can play.
- 5. **The MRC Learning Journey and Student Charter** students push themselves to meet academic and personal targets each day to better themselves and 'bring out the best in everyone'.
