Quick Guides

Uniform

Wearing the correct uniform correctly is very important at MRC. Uniform shows a sense of belonging and pride in being a member of our school community. Our uniform is smart and is gender neutral. It is important students adhere to our uniform standards – a brief overview is below:

- 1. **Make-up, false eye lashes, and acrylic nails:** make-up can be worn by students, but it must be discreet. This means that it must not be noticeable. If students wear make-up that does not meet this criteria, we will supply make-up removal wipes and students will be asked to remove it. Acrylic nails and false eye lashes are not suitable to be worn in school and we will contact you to ask that these are removed.
- 2. Jewellery: students are not permitted to wear jewellery in school, other than a watch and a plain gold or silver stud earrings in the lobe only. Facial/nose/tongue/cartilage piercings are not allowed and students will need to remove these.
- 3. Wearing our uniform correctly: skirts must be knee-length, shirts must be tucked in.
- 4. Jumpers: students can wear a jumper (Stevensons) under their blazer this is an optional item of the uniform and cannot be worn instead of the blazer. Hoodies/sweatshirts are not permitted in school.
- 5. **Footwear:** shoes must be black. Trainers/canvas shoes are not permitted. Black socks or tights only are permitted.
