

## Pupil Premium Impact: 2017/18

### Context and Outcomes: Year 11 2017/18

There were 25 students within the Year 11 cohort in 2017/18; this was 16% of the year group. The average ability of the PP students was 26.3, significantly below that of non-PP students (28.3). The difference between PP and non-PP achievement continued to improve year on year, as the tables below indicates.

This data is generated internally in college and will be checked when our 2018 data is externally validated later this term.
