## Year 7 Exam Week Arrangements - W/C 15<sup>th</sup> June 2026

As we approach the Year 7 summer assessments, taking place in the week beginning 15th June, it is important that students begin to revise regularly and develop effective study habits.

Revision lists for each subject will be shared with pupils on Arbor. In the lead-up to the assessments, teaching staff will be setting revision as homework (rather than additional tasks), allowing students to focus on building strong and structured revision routines. We encourage you to discuss this with your child and support them in creating a revision plan at home, as this will help them prepare in a more organised and confident way.

Please find below the assessment timetable. Assessments will take place in designated classrooms and will last for between 30 minutes and 1 hour, with longer papers for most Year 10 subjects. Pupils should bring appropriate revision materials and a reading book for use once they have completed their assessment.

### Timetable structure for the week:

- Pupils will follow an adjusted timetable, with break and lunchtimes slightly adjusted to fit around their assessments.
- Assessments will take place during Periods 1 and 2, followed by break.
- A further assessment will take place during Periods 3 and 4.
- After lunch, a further assessment will take place during Periods 5 and 6.
